**PROVIDING FOR AND ESTABLISHING THREE SINGLE-MEMBER COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS OF EQUAL POPULATION, REQUIRING THAT COMMISSIONERS BE RESIDENTS OF THE DISTRICT FROM WHICH THEY ARE ELECTED, AND PROVIDING THAT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS BE ELECTED FROM EACH DISTRICT BY THE VOTERS OF THE WHOLE COUNTY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 4-38-3(B), NMSA 1978, AS AMENDED; AND RESCINDING AND SUPERSEDING ANY PREVIOUS RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS:** Section 4-38-3(B), NMSA 1978, as amended, provides

(i) that a county having a population of thirteen thousand or fewer according to the most recent federal decennial census, may be divided by the board of county commissioners into single-member districts;

(ii) that if the county is districted, the districts shall be as equal in population as possible, numbered respectively to correspond to the number of members of the board of county commissioners, and county commissioners shall be residents of the district from which they are elected;

(iii) that in a county with only three board members, the board of county commissioners may require that commissioners shall be elected from each district by the voters of the whole county; and

**WHEREAS:** According to the 2020 federal decennial census, the population of Guadalupe County is four thousand four hundred fifty two (4,452), making the above provisions and requirements of Section 4-38-3(B) applicable to Guadalupe County; and
